PAI Partners to acquire ADB from Montagu Private Equity

ADB more than doubled profits under Montagu ownership

Strong continued growth prospects due to increased international and emerging market exposure

PAI Partners ("PAI") today announced the acquisition of ADB Solutions ("ADB" or "the Company"), the world leader in airfield lighting, from Montagu Private Equity ("Montagu"). The terms of the transaction, which is subject to regulatory clearances, were not disclosed.

ADB is the worldwide leader in Airfield Ground Lighting (AGL) products, systems and solutions, serving over 2,000 airports across more than 175 countries internationally. The Company develops, manufactures, and sells a comprehensive portfolio of AGL products and services for airports of all sizes, from large international hubs to smaller airports, military bases and heliports. ADB is headquartered in Brussels, with manufacturing presence in the USA and China and a global network of sales offices and distributors.

Montagu acquired ADB from Siemens in 2009 and created an independent company "ADB Solutions". Since then profits have more than doubled and the company has expanded internationally, increasing its exposure to emerging markets including China, South America and the Middle East. The company generates approximately €160m of revenues, 45% of which now come from emerging markets. The company's growth and internationalisation reflect the increasing demand for airport infrastructure across the world and rising standards and requirements in terms of safety, reliability and efficiency.

Laurent Rivoire, a Partner at PAI Partners, said:

"We are delighted to invest in ADB. It is the world leader in its sector, with strong growth prospects, and it is another investment in one of our core areas of expertise. We see excellent potential to expand the business footprint, particularly in emerging markets, where demand for airport infrastructure is rapidly increasing, and to benefit from the increased penetration of LED lamps, where ADB is market leader. We are also looking forward to working with ADB management and facilitating growth, both organically and through selective acquisitions."

"We are very proud to have partnered with ADB over the past 4 years. Under Montagu's ownership, ADB has become an independent company following the successful carve-out from Siemens, opened a site in China, strengthened its product ranges, made a strategic technology-focused acquisition, and invested heavily in its R&D capabilities and people. ADB is now a truly global market leader, with an enhanced technological leadership and market coverage. This is a good illustration of our strategy to invest in high quality companies with potential to benefit significantly from partnering with





Montagu. The success of the Company is testament to its talented management team and we wish the whole company continued success in its new partnership with PAI."
